# Immediate Sustainability and Integration

- ❖ Webinar/curriculum that include CE credits
- ❖ Curriculum/presentations used for onboarding training
- ❖ Incorporate key elements of transnational checklist
- ❖ Medical intake revised to include specific ethnic group
- ❖ Integrate abbreviated transnational checklist
- ❖ TBD: matching PR care coordinators to PR patients



# Next Steps - Internal

- ❖ Work with Case Management training agency to include transnational perspective
- ❖ Extend these trainings to disease intervention staff and state bridge counselors



## Next Steps - Government & Other Collaborators

- ❖ Meet with Local Health Jurisdiction to discuss retention in care strategies from SPNS program to integrate into medical case management
- ❖ Investigate how other programs (CBA, state and others) can integrate lessons learned from this project
- ❖ Propose transnational approach (with costing data) to future potential funders



# Overarching Lessons Learned

- ❖ Disseminate new transnational tools (fact sheets and others) and concepts from this program to the providers who are already used to working with diverse Latino populations
- ❖ Use websites and other platforms to disseminate findings/tools
- ❖ Share complexity of these transnational issues along with these tools as providers/agencies ‘drill down’ on contextual issues that impact continuum



# Funding and Other Opportunities

- ❖ Pursue future avenues (HRSA, SAMHSA, CDC) for funding that address retention and utilize transnational lessons learned
- ❖ Pursue future (smaller) avenues for funding that address provider training and utilize transnational lessons learned
- ❖ Recruitment strategies from this project are informing all HIV linkage/retention efforts at agency
